NORMAN ASBJORNSON , patiently handled early, advanced along the rail leaving the backstretch, eased out to the three path midway on the turn, responded to brisk, left hand whipping entering the stretch, closed determinedly under a hand ride and drove clear late. EIGHTTOFASTTOCATCH sped to the early lead, saved ground setting the pace, opened a lengthy advantage on the far turn then gave way grudgingly. JAVERRRE saved ground around the far turn, was set down for the drive, responded willingly but lacked the necessary rally to threaten the winner. KOH I NOOR , unhurried two wide the first turn, was in the two path on the far turn and failed to rally. CONCEALED IDENTITY saved ground the first turn, swung wide in upper stretch and was outrun. HUGHES NEXT , three wide the first turn, saved ground on the far turn but was outrun.
