Footnotes

TEDDY'S PROMISE stalked off the rail then outside a rival, bid three deep into the stretch, gained the advantage nearing midstretch and pulled clear late under urging. SUGARINTHEMORNING between horses early, stalked just off the rail then inside into and on the turn, swung out into the stretch and edged a rival late for the place. KINDLE sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, fought back along the rail in midstretch and to deep stretch, then could not match the winner and lost second late. DISTRACTING prompted the pace outside a rival then stalked just off the rail to the stretch and was outfinished for a minor award. BELLE OF THE HALL chased between horses then off the rail, continued a bit off the fence on the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. JOURNALISTE (ARG) saved ground chasing the pace, dropped back into the turn and lacked the necessary response in the stretch. PINK LOLLIPOPS stalked three deep then outside on the turn and three wide into the stretch and weakened. JOURNALISTE and TEDDY'S PROMISE wore calks.
