SAHARA SKY chased off the rail then three deep leaving the backstretch, went four wide on the turn and three wide into the stretch, came out some and rallied under left handed urging to get up in late stretch. ČAPITAL ACCOUNT unhurried along the inside early, came out on the turn and four wide into the stretch and finished well. COMMA TO THE TOP had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away a bit off the rail in midstretch and held on well but was caught late. DRILL settled off the inside, went four wide leaving the backstretch, continued outside on the turn and three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. JUSTIN PHILLIP dueled outside a rival on the backstretch and turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. MIDNIGHT TRANSFER stalked between horses on the backstretch and again on the turn, found the rail in the stretch but could not offer the needed late kick. THE LUMBER GUY stalked off the rail then between foes, was three wide between horses on the turn and had little left for the stretch. CANONIZE bobbled at the start, was between foes early then angled in and stalked inside, came out a bit in the stretch and weakened.
