**Footnotes**

ENTERPRISING chased inside then a bit off the rail, went between horses leaving the backstretch, steadied in tight into the second turn, continued just off the fence on that turn, came out in the stretch, bid three deep past the eighth pole, gained the lead under left handed urging in deep stretch and held gamely. QUOTIENT pulled his way along three deep, chased outside or alongside a rival, came out four wide into the stretch and closed willingly. HOME RUN KITTEN broke a bit slowly, settled inside, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and rallied gamely three deep on the line. DIAMOND BACHELOR stalked early then bid three deep on the backstretch, continued outside a rival nearing the second turn, bid again alongside a foe on that turn, put a head in front in midstretch, fought back between horses past midstretch and weakened some late. CRAFTSMAN (IRE) had good early speed and dueled outside a rival then between foes on the backstretch, inched away briefly into the second turn, fought back inside on that bend and in the stretch and also weakened some late. ROYAL BANKER (GB) pulled his way along three deep then chased outside a rival, went three wide on the second turn and into the stretch and drifted inward in the drive and did not rally. HORSE LAUGH chased a bit off the rail then inside on the second turn, came out into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. PUPPY MANNERS broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail, went outside on the second turn and three wide into the stretch and did not rally. NO MA'AM had good early speed and dueled inside, dropped back on the second turn and had little left for the stretch.
