R FREE ROLL moved up to take the lead after the start, set the pace through solid fractions, vied off the rail on the turn, shook clear into the stretch, responded well when set down after straightening for the drive, was put to a right-hand whip near the furlong marker and proved best under good handling. MY WANDY'S GIRL was coaxed along on the outside, advanced four wide on the turn, came under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, pursued the winner on the outside and finished willingly for the place. MERRY MEADOW showed some early speed, kept LA VERDAD in after R FREE ROLL took the lead, chased the latter rival on the outside, inched closer while in the three path on the turn, pursued the winner under a drive into the final furlong and weakened while able to get the show. SPEEDINTHRUTHCITY settled near the back, was urged along while two then three wide on the turn, swung five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed kick. LA VERDAD was away well from the inside post but beaten to the lead, raced just off the pace while being kept to the inside by MERRY MEADOW, saved ground while under some urging on the turn, cut the corner into the stretch before shifting out some and also lacked the needed kick. CALISTOGA settled on the outside, was urged along while four wide on the turn, moved closer while under a drive, swung six wide into the stretch and came up empty.
