FOR FILLIES THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$300 each which should accompany the nomination; \$1,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$3,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 twice allowed 2 lbs.; \$60,000 in 2014, 4 lbs.; two races, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter, restricted and restricted stake races not considered in allowances). Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. CClosed Saturday, August 16, 2014 with 18 Nominations.

Footnotes

STONETASTIC came away in good order, displayed outstanding speed, set the pace through fairly quick fractions, controlled the action while along the rail on the turn, was set down at the three-sixteenths, extended the advantage under a strong hand ride while being handled with loose reins, drew off under a strong hand ride until inside the sixteenth-pole then was eased up in the final few strides while much the best. MISS BEHAVIOUR tracked the pace on the outside, chased three wide on the turn, pursued the winner in upper stretch, was put to a right-handed whip approaching the furlong marker and proved no match while just able to get the place. SOUTHERN HONEY brushed with an opponent at the start, raced just off the pace while stuck inside of MISS BEHAVIOUR, chased in the two path on the turn, came under the whip in upper stretch and also proved no match for the winner but missed the place. TEA TIME broke out but was quickly corrected, was coaxed along on the outside, went three wide on the turn, shifted four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. WHO'S IN TOWN was urged along while off the pace, went around the turn in the two path, came three wide into the stretch, bumped with PRINCESS VIOLET while only in contention for the minor awards at the sixteenth-pole and failed to respond. SWEET WHISKEY settled in the early going then came under urging, went four wide on the turn, shifted five wide into the stretch and was no factor. PRINCESS VIOLET bobbed outward at the start, settled at the rear, angled in inside the five-eighths pole, raced inside for most of the turn, shifted three wide at the quarter-pole, had the rider drop his left rein at the sixteenth-pole, came out and bumped with WHO'S IN TOWN and never reached contention. THIRTEEN ARROWS broke a half step slow and was last away, moved up on the inside to be well placed, chased along the rail on the turn, cut the corner into the stretch and tired.
