**Footnotes**

DANK (GB) was rated between foes just off the second flight in the opening half, shifted out four wide nearing upper stretch and produced a solid closing response to wrest command and move well clear under a right handed tap and firm encouragement. GIFTED GIRL (IRE) was guided to the inside early tracking the leaders behind the second flight into the second bend, switched out five wide in upper stretch and continued with interest to prove best of the others. AUSUS settled last while angling to the rail racing into the backstretch, saved ground throughout and made late progress to gain some position late while earning a share. MARKETING MIX was prompted to contend three deep tracking just off the first flight racing to the backstretch, lodged a brief bid in that path racing through the far turn, then finished evenly between foes in the final quarter. LA TIA moved to the fore from the outset to dictate the pace a bit off the rail, disputed the issue inside foes into the second bend to upper stretch and gave out in late stages. SOLID APPEAL, forwardly placed tracking just off the pacesetter in the opening stages, pressed the issue between foes on the far turn to upper stretch and gave way leaving the furlong marker. DUNTLE (IRE), held up inside tracking the leaders as part of the second flight racing to the far turn, came up empty entering upper stretch. ARTEMUS KITTEN settled outside foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch, was fanned five wide racing through the far turn and offered no rally. STARFORMER was a brief factor three deep in the second flight racing to the backstretch but dropped out of contention early.
