SWEET CASSIOPEIA was bumped at the start, settled in hand four wide, steadied inside the seven-sixteenths pole, moved up between rivals, came four wide into the lane, caught POINT TO THE WILD inside the furlong marker and edged clear. POINT TO THE WILD tracked the pace three wide, forged command entering the stretch, continued on well but was unable to resist the winner. QUEEN NEGWER was slow into stride, moved up through the turn, tipped out five wide and was along for the show. COSTLY set the pace three wide, was headed entering the stretch, weakened and gave way. SATURDAY NTHE PARK was forwardly placed along the inside, but flattened in the final furlong and faded. DIXIE JACKPOT went wide and failed to threaten. MARCASITE bumped with the winner at the start, was close up four wide, but stopped leaving the turn.
