FOR FILLIES AND MARES FOUR YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. Free nomination, \$750 to pass the entry box. Nominations close April 3, 2010. Purse will be \$250,000 guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing 7th through last, 60% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to 6th. Supplemental nominations of \$12,500.00. Entries close Wednesday April 14, 2010, by usual time of closing. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes in 2010 allowed 3 lbs; non-winners of \$22,000 in 2010, allowed 5 lbs.; a race other than maiden or claiming in 2010 allowed 7 lbs. Field will be limited to ten starters with four on the alternates list. Preference to stakes winners in order (Grade I, Grade II, Grade III), then stakes winners, then highest earnings in 2009-2010. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Trophy to the winning owner, trainer and jockey.

PINKARELLA broke out, moved to the lead three wide approaching the first turn, saved ground to rate a clear pace down the backstretch, edged away from the quarter pole and widened through the stretch in a strong finish. SWEET GOODBYE rated close off the rail, had aim into the final turn, proved no match for the winner though finished well in a clear place. STRUT THE CANARY, pinched back at the start, settled off the pace about the four path, finished evenly and just lasted for show. UNFORGOTTEN rated back off the rail and passed a tiring rival. SWISH MARAVICH saved ground racing well back. EAST BREAKS rated off the pace inside then faded from the quarter pole. CALL OF A LION was kept just off the early pace four wide but gave way after three eighths.
