SHE'S A TIGER had speed off the rail then dueled outside a rival, took a short lead leaving the turn, kicked clear under urging in the stretch and held gamely. FASCINATING settled outside a rival then between horses on the backstretch and turn, came out four wide into the stretch and finished well. CONCAVE saved ground chasing the pace, came off the rail in the stretch and bested the others. SECRET COMPASS angled in and saved ground off the pace, continued on the inside on the turn and in the stretch and made up some ground but was not a serious threat. SOUTHERN SUNSHINE bobbled some at the start, chased three deep on the backstretch and turn, came four wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. BAJAN chased outside a rival then between horses, came three wide into the stretch, bumped with a foe in upper stretch and lacked the needed rally. AWESOME BABY broke in a bit, had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back under urging leaving the turn and weakened in the stretch. SPROUTS stalked a bit off the rail on the backstretch and turn, drifted out some and was bumped between horses in upper stretch and weakened.
