CANDREA broke out bit, content to track pacesetter while slightly off the rail, bided time until the final turn, quickly moved past that rival on the bend and kicked clear, drifted inward in the stretch and scored convincingly under one crack of the whip and taken in hand nearing the wire. REAL DREAM unhurried from along the fence, chased inside then came off the rail, under strong asking while two wide into the stretch and powered away for the place. LASSO FROM EL PASO was sent to the front, controlled the fractions from the inside, had little answer for the winner on the final bend and weakened from the inside. I SENSE YOUR LUCK settled outside rival, stalked two wide then came three wide into the stretch while never a serious challenger. WILD HICKORY raced three wide around the first turn then four wide entering the stretch, came in late but was outrun. DUALITY reserved along the rail, chased inside, dropped back into and around the final turn and was eased approaching the wire.
