Footnotes

TURBULENT DESCENT bobbled slightly at the start, stalked the pace inside, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch, gained the lead outside MAY DAY ROSE in midstretch, inched away and drifted in, was flagged with the whip once left handed and proved best under a steady hand ride. BIG TIZ pulled her way along to stalk the pace off the rail then outside the winner on the second turn, came out four wide into the stretch, also drifted in through the final furlong but gained the place. TELL A KELLY unhurried and allowed to settle off the rail chasing the pace, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch and rallied past a rival late for the show. MAY DAY ROSE pulled a bit and prompted the pace outside a rival then stalked off the rail, bid again on the second turn, dueled for the lead, took a short advantage nearing the stretch, fought back inside the winner in midstretch, weakened some late and was outfinished for third. ZAZU three deep into the first turn, chased outside a rival on the backstretch and off the rail on the second turn, came out some in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. TRUE WAY OF GRACE saved ground chasing the pace, came out some in the stretch and again in midstretch and could not offer the necessary response. NINA FEVER sped to the early lead a bit off the rail, inched away inside on the backstretch, dueled along the fence on the second turn and into the stretch, then weakened. LUNA GRANDE broke a bit slowly, settled just off the rail then outside a rival on the backstretch and second turn and did not rally.
