

JUDY THE BEAUTY settled between rivals, shifted out four wide and ranged up to join the vanguard leaving the turn, kick clear and held comfortably. BETTER LUCKY was allowed to settle, circled five wide to make her bid, finished well but failed to menace the winner. APROPOS attended the pace toward the inside, tipped out between horses on the turn, was bottled up leaving the turn and into the lane, angled out to find room inside the three-sixteenths pole, was floated out through the final furlong, but continued on willingly. HEIR KITTY settled saving ground, closed the gap through the turn, came three wide into the stretch, lacked room with a furlong to run, altered course to the outside but lacked the needed late response. EDEN PRAIRIE disputed the pace three wide through the turn, then along the inside to the final furlong and faltered. COZZE UP LADY tracked the pace three wide, moved up to engage the leaders leaving the turn, loomed a danger but failed to sustain the drive. BYRAMA (GB) was unhurried into stride, swung seven wide entering the stretch, was carried out further and failed to threaten. WILDCAT LILY vied for the lead along the inside for five furlongs and stopped.
