Footnotes

LOVELY BERNADETTE attended the pace along the inside, shifted out leaving the second turn, caught I'M BETTY G inside the sixteenth pole and shook clear. JOURNEY HOME was unhurried between horses, angled out a quarter mile from home, finished with a rush and was just up to earn the place. I'M BETTY G opened clear to dictate terms, turned back the bid of DEFIANT HONOR with five-sixteenths to run, shook loose entering the stretch, was collared again inside the sixteenth marker, was unable to go on with the winner and just failed to hold the runner up spot. FAULT settled in hand between horses, came four wide into the lane, angled in and found a seam toward the inside, continued on well and was making up ground. DEFIANT HONOR tracked three wide, moved up to engage I'M BETTY G midway through the second turn, but flattened between runners in the drive and faded. CHASTISE settled saving ground, tipped out between horses entering the stretch, but toiled fruitlessly through the final furlong. SULLY'S DREAM came away a step slow, was pinched back between rivals, tucked in to save ground, got through and improved position. FIZZY FRIDAY (GB) contended four wide, was collared between horses entering the stretch and failed to make headway. LET IT RIDE MOM contended between horses, moved out four wide entering the stretch but

weakened during the drive. PRINCESS LA QUINTA was squeezed at the start and slow into stride, was rank to place in traffic, leveled into stride along the inside but lacked a response when called upon. DOLCE LILI failed to respond. YOUNGEST DAUGHTER was close up three wide, loomed a danger leaving the second turn, but came up empty entering the stretch. LADIES' PRIVILEGE was never a factor.
