VOODOO STORM unhurried early gave a quick move along the inside on the far turn moving well clear in upper stretch, kept to task in the three path continued on as much the best. JOY BOY veered in bumping RAGING DAOUST at the break, was hustled on lead through the backside, engaged by VOODOO STORM leaving the far turn quickly proved no match staying on in the four path to salvage place. GOOD LORD away slowly stayed back to the half, advanced modestly on the far turn racing three path in upper stretch going evenly from the eighth pole to best the others. RAGING DAOUST bumped at the break tracked the pace going evenly to the far turn, would waver there fading from contention along the inside. RUSSELL ROAD raced a step slow in mid pack flattening out on the far turn. FLEET EAGLE rushed out prompted the pace through the backside, began to wear down on the far turn wilting into upper stretch. SKY VENTURE close up early gave quick retreat on the backside. A. P. CINO away slowly would trail throughout.
