RECRUITING READY broke near the back, moved up inside to be clear before a quarter, showed the way through the turn, called on for some additional run when straightened for home, kicked well clear in a sharp effort. CONQUEST WILDCAT forwardly placed while racing just off the inside, two path into the lane, proved no match for the winner, clearly second best. SILVER BULLION early bump, lacked early foot, three path through the turn, asked along a quarter out, too much to do with the top pair, narrowly gained the nod for the show. JAGGED WARRIOR devoid of early foot, saved ground out of the turn, mild rally to miss the show. CRAWFORD settled early behind the pace, advanced and moved closer along the inside turning for home, flattened out in the drive. CARSON KAN remained always back. ROCKSHAW forwardly placed while racing three wide, came out a bit to be four wide turning for home, faltered in the drive.
