Footnotes

PIANIST sprinted to a clear early lead, set the pace along the rail, responded when asked in upper stretch and was under a brisk drive the final furlong. HARD NOT TO LIKE stumbled leaving the starting gate, saved ground, stalked the pace, eased off the rail in midstretch then flattened out. APPEALING CAT lacked speed, was two wide leaving the far turn, eased out in upper stretch and rallied mildly. SAMITAR (GB), well back early, raced four wide turning for home and failed to be a factor. CHARGED COTTON stumbled leaving the starting gate, raced along the rail in the stretch and failed to be a factor. EMBARR, fanned to the five path turning for home, was outrun. SILVER SCREAMER chased the pace outside the winner and gave way in upper stretch. OLD TUNE (BRZ), never far back, eased out to the three path leaving the far turn and faltered in upper stretch.
