FOR THREE YEAR OLDS WHICH HAVE NOT WON A GRADED SWEEPSTAKES OVER A MILE IN 2014. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination; \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$2,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Weight 123 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstake at a mile or over in 2014 allowed 2 lbs., of two races other than maiden, claiming or starter at a mile or over in 2014 allowed 4 lbs.; such a race in 2014 allowed 6 lbs. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, July 12, 2014 with 23 Nominations.

V. E. DAY broke a bit slow, raced a touch off the inside on the first turn, was unhurried at the rear, saved ground early on the far turn then came off the rail, angled four wide while getting closer outside the quarter-pole, swung six wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside, made a bid near the eighth-pole, battled with two opponents in the final furlong and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. CHARGE NOW settled just off the pace while off the inside, shifted four wide midway through the far turn, came five wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside to make a bid, battled gamely in the final furlong and just missed. PROTONICO raced inside on the first turn, was well placed just off the pace, chased in the two path on the far turn, made a bid in upper stretch, battled determinedly along the rail in the final furlong and also just missed. VIVA MAJORCA raced inside on the first turn, settled towards the back, moved closer while inside on the far turn, lost position while hesitant to advance along the rail coming to the quarter-pole, steadied some then shifted out over heels, came three wide into the stretch, moved out under a left-handed whip, reached the outside at the furlong marker and finished fast but was too late. SPOT raced in the two path on the first turn, settled on the outside, moved closer while in the two path on the far turn, steadied off heels approaching the quarter-pole, shifted three wide into the stretch, came between horses at the three-sixteenths and lacked the needed response. JOINT CUSTODY went three wide on the first turn while in hand, moved up to contest the pace on the outside, vied two to three wide on the far turn, dropped back under a drive in upper stretch and gave way. LIFE IN SHAMBLES was fractious in the gate then backed out and reloaded, went four wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased three to four wide on the far turn and came up empty. TIZ'NAZ was fractious in the gate then hustled from the start, raced in the two path on the first turn, contested the pace on the inside of JOINT CUSTODY, vied along the rail while urged along on the far turn and faded. COUSIN STEPHEN went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, dropped back while four wide on the far turn and faltered.
