GUN RUNNER broke very well then was hustled, went three wide early on the first turn then dropped to the two path, stalked the pace on the outside, took the lead outside the half-mile pole, had an opponents thrown shoe get entangled in his tail, controlled the action while inside on the far turn, responded well when set down under a strong hand ride in upper stretch, extended the advantage into the final furlong, was given one crack of a left-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole then proved much the best under a solid hand ride to the wire. KEEN ICE stumbled at the start then brushed with a rival, saved ground on the first turn, was unhurried at the rear of the field, moved out leaving the backstretch, went three wide on the far turn, was roused near the five-sixteenths, came four wide into the stretch, was put to a left-handed whip at the three-sixteenths, drifted out some in the vicinity of the furlong marker, was straightened by the rider shortly thereafter and got up for the place. BREAKING LUCKY was asked leaving the gate, saved ground on the first turn, was well placed just off the pace, passed the half-mile pole under urging, chased in the two path on the far turn, turned into the stretch under the whip, chased the winner under a drive past the three-sixteenths then weakened but was clear for the show. WAR STORY brushed with DISCREET LOVER while inside on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was urged along while inside for most of the far turn, moved off the rail outside the quarter-pole, swung five wide into the stretch and failed to respond. DISCREET LOVER brushed with WAR STORY on the first turn, went two to three wide on that bend, was reserved on the outside, rounded the far turn in the two path while urged along, came under the whip in upper stretch and also failed to respond. TU BRUTUS (CHI) brushed with KEEN ICE at the start, raced in the two path early on the first turn then became rank under restraint while moving to the three path, was rated on the outside while tugging at the bit, dropped back some at the half-mile pole, was urged along in the three path on the far turn and capitulated. CAUTIOUS GIANT was asked from the gate, dropped to the rail early on the first turn, set the pace, lost the lead to GUN RUNNER outside the half-mile pole, threw a shoe in the vicinity of that marker, chased along the rail on the far turn and stopped.
