INNER TURF FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination; \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 at a mile or over allowed 2 lbs.; two races other than maiden, claiming or starter at a mile or over in 2014 allowed 4 lbs.; such a race in 2014 allowed 6 lbs. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the main track. Closed Saturday, August 9, 2014 with 25 Original Nominations and 1 Supplement. (Rail at 18 feet).

Footnotes

HEART TO HEART went to the front, set the pace on the inside through reasonable fractions, responded well when set down in upper stretch, drew off into the final furlong and proved much the best under steady urging. LOS BORRACHOS raced inside on the first turn, was unhurried at the rear, saved ground while urged along early on the far turn, came off the rail outside the quarter-pole, swung six wide into the stretch and finished with good energy to get the place. PURE SENSATION lunged slightly at the start, moved up then tracked the pace on the outside, chased in the two path on the far turn, was given a tap of a right-handed whip approaching the quarter-pole, pursued the winner under continued right-hand urging in upper stretch, switched to a left-handed whip inside the furlong marker and weakened while able to get the show. HERE'S JOHNNY brushed with an opponent just after the start, was rated inside on the first turn then well placed down the backstretch, glided behind the leader while along the rail on the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, chased under a right-handed whip into the final furlong, switched to a left-handed whip shortly thereafter and tired. MARK MY WAY bumped with CRAFTSMAN after the start, was very keen while off the rail through the first turn, continued headstrong on the backstretch while reserved, was given free rein in the vicinity of the quarter-pole, shifted four wide into the stretch, jostled with CRAFTSMAN inside the three-sixteenths, dropped closer to the inside and came up empty. STORMING INTI broke in and bumped with a rival, went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn and capitulated. CRAFTSMAN (IRE) was bumped on both sides just after the start then squeezed back, raced off the rail on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch, jostled with MARK MY WAY inside the three-sixteenths and failed to threaten. (Rail at 18 Feet)
