STORMY ADVENTURE prompted the pace outside MAID FOR JOE around the turn, then pressed the winner in the stretch before weakening in the late stages. STEELY circled the turn three wide, floated to the four path entering the stretch then passed tired horses. TOURING HONG KONG, three wide on the turn, chased the pace and gave way. MYSTIC LOVE saved ground on the turn, swung to the three path entering the stretch then failed to rally. KISSED BY THE MIST, steadied in traffic near the five eighths pole, was outrun. MAID FOR JOE showed speed along the rail, drifted out a bit entering the stretch and faltered in mid stretch.

MOTHERLOAD HIPSTER bobbled at the break to away last, was patiently handled while saving ground, began her run leaving the half mile pole, was guided off the inside mid turn, responded to left hand pressure inside the quarter pole, closed determinedly to take over a sixteenth out then edged clear. FRANSTEIN advanced under snug rating while saving ground nearing the turn, angled out soon after and took dead aim on the leader, moved to command under confident handling in upper stretch, kicked clear when roused soon after, met the challenge of the winner past the eighth pole then gave way grudgingly. LADY OUTFLANKER , outrun early while saving ground, swung out for the drive and had some belated action. JUST SAY GOODBYE cleared early and angled in towards the rail, set a rated pace to the head of the lane, was headed a quarter mile out, gave some chase to the furlong marker then surrendered. WAKINA , hustled along off the rail, failed to respond. SECRET LIFE OF BEA , between rivals early stalking the pace, circled four wide into the lane and gave way. CENTRIPETAL MOTION lacked speed, was ridden along four wide mid turn but failed to respond. LISETTE , three to four wide chasing the early pace, faltered.

PAGAN PRIESTESS , two wide between horses in a forward position, was alertly angled to the inner rail inside the three sixteenths pole, slipped through a narrow opening inside WEEPER and drove clear. WEEPER sped to the early lead, set the pace near the rail, drifted out a bit in upper stretch, came in to narrow the quarters on PAGAN PRIESTESS in midstretch, drifted out a bit near the sixteenth pole and gave way grudgingly. DANCE WITH GIO worked between horses in the stretch, altered course to the inside of WEEPER near the sixteenth pole and finished gamely. BALTIMORE BELLE stalked the pace outside horses, circled the far turn three wide, had aim on the lead in midstretch then flattened out. MORAL HIGH GROUND lacked speed, swung widest in upper stretch and closed the gap late. DREAM LOUISE lacked speed, was not a factor and passed tired foes late. DAYDREAMIN GRACIE saved ground and gave way in upper stretch. THISDANSEISTAKEN prompted the pace outside WEEPER and faltered in upper stretch.

ANZIO ADAM saved ground stalking the pace, drifted out a bit entering the stretch and faded in the drive. MONEY FOR LOVE saved ground on the turn, came off the rail entering the stretch and weakened. CHIEF DISPUTE , in the three path entering the stretch, was not a factor. MINE FOR LOVE , unhurried, had a seven wide trip entering the stretch. SHOOKSTOWN ROAD , five wide entering the stretch, was not a factor. LET ME BE FRANK stalked the pace, floated to the five path entering the stretch then gave way. FRISKIE J was not a factor. SUTTON ROAD , steadied in close quarters soon after the break, stalked the pace between horses and faltered in upper stretch.
