CLASSY COCO settled off of a quick early pace while removed from the rail, responded when given her cue three wide leaving the three eighths pole, made a bold run to collar JONESIN FOR JERRY in upper stretch, kicked clear inside the three sixteenths marker then eagerly widened when put to left handed encouragement. STEADY N LOVE , taken to rate while saving ground, angled out leaving the far turn, advanced inside the winner mid turn, altered out to about the four path in upper stretch and gave willing pursuit to the wire. JONESIN FOR JERRY tracked the pace three deep past near the half mile pole, dropped in a path and moved in hand to collar the leader mid turn, took over without much coaxing near the quarter pole, could not withstand the winner's charge in upper stretch, held well to the eighth pole then faded. COCO PUNCH , a bit fractious just prior to the gates being sprung, broke a bit slowly, raced well off the early pace, came three wide for the drive and could not muster up a significant rally. DRESS UP quickly established a clear lead, set a strong pace towards the rail, was joined soon past the three eighths pole, remained a presence to the quarter then dropped back. BEAR MOON stalked the early pace between rivals, was under strong urging pursuing the leaders leaving the five sixteenths pole, failed to sustain after five furlongs and retreated. ANN'S SMART DANCER bobbed at the break and failed to menace. INSPIRED SAY EYE flashed speed inside, remained a forward position to the far turn then faltered.

HEAVENLY ENCORE , wide the far turn, rallied mildly outside horses. MOMMA'S MYSTERY raced in mid pack for six furlongs, swung wide entering the stretch and passed tired rivals. JAR OF HEARTS chased the pace two wide, bid for the lead between horses mid way on the far turn, chased the winner to mid stretch and weakened late. AURELIA AUGUSTA hesitated at the break, failed to be a factor and passed tired horses. SO HELP ME HANNAH , rank inside horses the first turn, saved ground in a forward position, steadied lacking room near the five sixteenths pole, found room along the rail entering the stretch, chased the winner to mid stretch then tired. MADONNA'S CONQUEST , five deep turning for home, was not a factor. FOR FINERY , fractious in the starting gate, raced wide the far turn and was outrun. BUFFED , a forward factor three deep, gave way. WILD FOR LOVE

saved ground and failed to rally in an even effort. NOUR IAYOUN , steadied in tight quarters leaving the chute, raced very wide entering the stretch and was not a factor. JITTERBUG , pinched back after stumbling at the break, raced six deep turning for home and was not a factor. DOPKE GAL , outrun to the stretch, passed tired horses. BREEZY GIRL , wide around the turn, failed to rally. ONEGREATSTEP , outrun, swung to the eight path in upper stretch. LUCY BOO was outrun. WILL N' PAT drifted in tightening quarters on rivals leaving the chute, chased the pace between horses, drifted wide entering the stretch and faltered. SAFARI , two wide turning for home, was not a factor. LILY'S PEAK hugged the rail, chased the pace and faltered.
