Footnotes

LADY JOANNE broke inward bumping with LEAR'S PRINCESS at the start, moved up from outside on the first turn, stalked the leaders while three wide along the backstretch, was confidently handled while edging closer on the far turn, made a run three wide to gain a slim lead at the quarter pole, came out slightly under left hand urging in upper stretch, moved back in under strong right hand whipping as OCTAVE made her move along the rail in midstretch, dug in when challenged by the runner-up in midstretch and prevailed after a long hard drive. LEAR'S PRINCESS checked slightly at the start, was unhurried for six furlongs, swung out on the far turn, made a strong four wide move to threaten the winner leaving the quarter pole, battled heads apart outside that one into deep stretch but could not get up. OCTAVE settled in good position along the rail leaving the first turn, raced just off the pace while saving ground along the backstretch, checked while blocked behind the leaders nearing the quarter pole, ducked to the rail for room in upper stretch, moved through along the fence to challenge nearing the furlong marker, raced in close quarters along the inside into deep stretch and yielded late. MOON CATCHER dropped far back in the early stages, was outrun along the backstretch, closed the gap considerably from outside on the turn, circled six wide to reach contention in upper stretch but couldn't threaten the top three. PANTY RAID, taken in hand early, was unhurried along the inside to the far turn, moved out while gaining midway on the turn, angled five wide at the quarter pole and lacked a strong closing response. TOUGH TIZ'S SIS took the lead soon after the start, dueled along the inside for seven furlongs, maintained a slim lead to the top of the stretch then tired from her early efforts. FOLK bumped at the start, contested the pace from outside along the backstretch, drew on even terms with the leader on the far turn, remained a factor to the top of the stretch then gave way. Following a stewards inquiry into the stretch run there was no change in the order of finish.
