VIRADIA away forwardly placed, was well held showing the way during the initial stages, cruised to control when ready during the setting of the second split, was comfortably in the clear stepping into the stretch, drew off, handily. STRAW HAT took up the chase from the two path, pulling on the right side all the while, was sent over to the inside route after the half had been completed, cut the corner into the stretch and went on to secure second. HOT POSSEBILITY three wide entering the turn, was fanned out into path five exiting it, got the show. NETTI'S LEGACY asked from the get-go, was out-sprinted, raced towards the inside until upper stretch, had no rally. REYANA REYA DREAMS two to three wide on the turn, was under a drive by the five-sixteenths pole, angled four wide into the stretch and had no offering. CAYMAN A BIKINI hustled along after springing from the gate to attain a prominent position, contended for the lead from the inside for nearly a half and gave way.
