OUR SUPER NOVA well off the inside throughout, went about the turn hung out four wide, was still in reserve taking over by a narrow margin as three-quarters was being completed, settled in and was put to a drive, was still clinging to the top as a duel with the runner up got ignited, fought stubbornly to the end and prevailed. BABY BOSS took up the chase from the two path on the turn, picked up interest prior to fanning out into path six for the drive home, narrowed in to begin the final furlong with dead aim on the eventual winner, tried hard but couldn't seal the deal. VIP NATION raced alongside HUG THE RAIL in the early going before seeing FOREVER DAISY take on the aforementioned foe right after the first fraction had been posted on the board, stalked the pair from the three path, hand urged on the turn, swung into the stretch, and mustered up a mild response sufficient enough to claim the show. FOREVER DAISY keen after springing from the starting gate, rushed up to the front runners, splitting them and grabbing a lead early on the backstretch, raced as a team HUNG THE RAIL afterwards, felt the presence of the top one as six furlongs was being reached, gave in despite being put to a drive, hung around as a prominent factor for another furlong before giving way. HUG THE RAIL disputed the pace from the inside route for three-quarters and faltered. MIDNIGHT SKY saved ground while trailing throughout.
