BEBE BANKER three then four wide in pursuit, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, swung four wide for home, rallied to take over command at the three-sixteenths and edged clear under a drive to prevail. PAPA JIM pulled on the bit keenly taking command seven furlongs from home and showed the spurring off resisting the rating hold of the rider, climbed a bit into the turn, came under challenge in earnest and was placed to coaxing at the five-sixteenths, swung two to three wide for home, yielded the front with three-sixteenths to go and ran on clear of the rest and was along second best. PIER FORTY hustled from the gate, led early on before being displaced seven furlongs out by the eager aforementioned foe, chased two to three wide in closest aim of that rival, came under coaxing three furlongs from home issuing a challenge through the latter portion of the bend, spun three wide into upper stretch, got rebuffed with three-sixteenths to go and weakened while along for the show honors. TOP OF THE MINT chased two to three wide under coaxing from the three-eighths, advanced offering a mild bid swinging five wide into upper stretch, couldn't sustain the momentum and weakened to the finish. TRUE BLUE GIANT four to five wide in pursuit, came under urging at the seven-sixteenths, went six wide into upper stretch, tired. DISCIPLANARIAN stumbled at the start recovering into BIG PADDY BROWN, chased along the inside, came under coaxing tipped three wide at the three-eighths, swung four wide for home and made no impact. BIG PADDY BROWN bumped at the start by the aforementioned foe who recovered inwards from a stumble, chased along the inside under a ride from midway on the turn, spun just off the inside for home and tired.
