### Footnotes

REAL DAN settled into midpack after the start, was three to four wide taking up the chase on the turn, came under stronger handling at the five-sixteenths marker, swung approximately five wide into the stretch, chipped away at the deficit, began to shy from whichever side stick work was used yet still struck the front in the general area of the sixteenth marker, saw the rider resort to a brisk hand ride afterwards, resulting in keeping a straighter course and kicking clear. BIG GEMMY tracked the front runners from the two path on the backstretch, shifted one farther off the rail at the midway point on the turn, got roused a sixteenth down the road, was about four wide turning into the stretch, saw the winner the first to overhaul SHAMROCK KID, continued on well enough to outfinish the last-mentioned foe late for the place. SHAMROCK KID hustled early to secure a forward position, had the rider resort to a more relaxed hold afterwards vying head to head with BOURBON DID IT to his left, began to inch away from the nemesis approaching the quarter pole, settled in at the top of the stretch and was given his cue, began the final furlong in possession of its largest lead, had it snatched away a sixteenth later, weakened enough in the seventy yards to lose second. VICAR'S LEGEND pursued the front runners from path two, made no headway in the last eighth. LATIN LOVE BUG parked out five wide on the turn, was never involved. PLAYWRIGHT failed to rally off a ground-saving journey. BOURBON DID IT along the inside route, duelled for command until deep into the furlong grounds before giving way. DUBLIN GREEN four wide on the turn, raced seven wide down the lane backing away. SAMS LAST GHASP sighted three wide at the top of the turn, gave way.
