FORT WORTH away without apparent mishap, was allowed to ease back early on the backstretch, sat poised three wide on the bend keeping watch on the front runners, crept up to the leader under some light hand urging as three-quarters was being completed, responded when switched over to brisk urging at the three-sixteenths marker to take charge, drew well clear before getting geared down in the final seventy yards. RED ZINGER worked out a tuck into the two path coming up to the top of the bend, wrestled away the lead at the five-sixteenths pole, was himself overhauled a furlong later, had no trouble whatsoever salvaging second. HE'SMYLUCKYFELLOW two wide on the turn, was along for the show. PAPA JIM remained towards the inside after the start, pulled on the bit for a good portion of the opening half, relinquished despite getting roused at the five-sixteenths pole, faded down the stretch. I SAW IT ALL taken hold of after getting away awkwardly, saved ground on the turn, angled approximately three wide into the stretch and gave way. DA BERG in the two path stepping onto the turn, was never in it.
