**Footnotes**

STARSHIP ZEUS off the inside throughout, was sighted in the two path at the midway point of the turn, swung into action by swinging six wide into the lane, kicked into its stride and closed in, shot by a threesome in the final sixteenth and edged away. SPECIAL STORY took up position in midpack after the field had been sent off and running, departed the backstretch from path three, picked up interest coming up to the five-sixteenths pole, advancing in unison with CREA'S BKLYN LAW towards the one to catch, challenged as the widest of three fighting front runners spinning into the lane, fought his way to a slim lead a short distance beyond the eighth pole, got reeled in about a sixteenth later, then stayed on well to procure the place. FLATEXCEL got set to an abbreviated ride after bobbling at the break, grabbed the advantage and cut over to the inside route, showed the way being shadowed by SWIPING DAN to the outside, saw that one being to fall back at the five-sixteenths pole but gained no relief, and was instead pounced upon by both the winner and CREA'S BKLYN LAW, yielded in the general area of the eighth pole after vying with vigour to the inside of them, showed some fight for another sixteenth before weakening. DESERT LIGHTS about four wide in pursuit of the pace, stepped into the lane under a drive, flattened out in the final furlong. CREA'S BKLYN LAW came in at the start, attained a forward position after being put back on course, was mostly two wide travelling on the turn, rallied in tandem with the second place finisher late on the turn, was between opponents putting in a stiff bid entering the lane, kept up with it until approximately a sixteenth remaining and tired. DOOLEY two wide onto the turn, was sent five wide exiting it, made no impact. PROXIMATE TO POWER taken hold shying in at the start, saved ground for three-quarters, wandered out into path seven in the lane to no avail. SANDY LANE pulling early, was briefly placed along the inside before

tipping back into the two path, angled four wide into the stretch and tired. SWIPING DAN stalked the pace two wide to the five-sixteenths marker, was not asked down the stretch, then was pulled up very quickly once over the finish line.
