Footnotes

LIGHTNING BUZZ off the inside throughout, pursued the front runners three wide on the turn, was given his cue at the five-sixteenths marker, swung slightly wider into the stretch, picked it up and emerged at the eighth pole as the new leader, edged away. TRULY A MOON SHOT cut over to the inside after bumping with another at the start, was called upon for more with a few jumps left in the run around the bend, cut the corner with full clearance along the inside corridor, closed the gap for next furlong, failed to keep pace with the winner once beyond the eighth pole but had enough left to nail down the place honors. DARING DESTINY shook off contact with ST. PATRICK FROST to grab control, set the opening splits spaced at a slight distance from off the rail, shifted into path two when put to a drive at the head of the stretch, relinquished a furlong later and weakened into the show slot. ASPHALT PAVING travelled two to three wide on the turn, was asked to pick up interest in the general area of the five-sixteenths marker, stepped into the stretch and altered course out towards path six, displayed some late energy. HAMPTONS HOLIDAY devoid of speed along the backstretch, unleashed a sustained rail run once onto the turn, wandered to the outside after entering the turn until approximately eighth wide, closed in belatedly. CONQUEST PRANKSTER put to brisk encouragement springing from the gate, failed to claim the top, went on stalk the leader from the two path until the furlong grounds before giving way. ST. PATRICK FROST bumped from both sides at the start, was strung out four wide on the turn, never made it into a contending position.
