FULL SALUTE alongside GETOFFMYBACK at the start, grabbed a slight advantage, got set up in the path two, showed the way, feeling pressure from BLUE BELT to the outside, completed the half with GETOFFMYBACK looming boldly to the left, responded when put to the test by that opponent during the next furlong and drew clear. HELOOKSTHEPART took up the chase from path two on the turn, fanned out into path five from upper to midstretch, rallied with good energy to get up for the place. GETOFFMYBACK well rated keeping an eye on the front runners from just off the rail, inched up to them just as the second split was about to be posted on the board, had sufficient room with which to launch a rally and was got called upon, fought fiercely but couldn't go by, continued onward and wound up nipped for second. BLUE BELT a bit reluctant to get into the starting gate, came away without apparent mishap, pressed the winner from path three for the opening half before giving way. ROMAN APPROVAL ridden after springing from the gate, but out-hustled by others for the top, underwent a four wide pursuit to the end of the bend and tired. BITUMEN over to the rail in short order, went about the turn under a drive, angled three to four wide into the stretch, had no gain.
