SHAMROCK KID moved towards the two path after the field had been sent on its way, was one of several vying for command during the initial stages, saw that early dispute develop into a one on one contest with the second place finisher late on the backstretch, cut over to the rail in time for the beginning of the run around the bend, maintained the edge, shifted more into the two path when put to a drive spinning onto the head of the stretch, saw CUARENTA whittle away at the deficit, but mustered up enough determination in the final stages to preserve the decision. CUARENTA away forwardly placed, wound up in tussle with the top one after the first fraction had been recorded, took part in it towards the two path, sputtered three wide when put to a drive for the drive home, closed in on the one to catch in a steadfast manner, loomed boldly in the final stages but failed to go by, then was subsequently vanned off. RUN FOR BOSTON was in the three path stepping onto the turn, got put to a prolonged drive, made it into the stretch and rallied for the show, although never posing a threat to the top twosome. SANTO ANTONIO in range racing in path two on the bend, got driven four wide into the stretch, straightened away and was outfinished. MILLIES PARTY BOY took up the chase towards path two during the early going, slid over to the rail at the midway point on the turn, arrived into the stretch and had no rally. THERESA'S BOY prominently placed three wide for three-quarters, swung a couple of paths farther off the inside into the stretch and tired. SHUFFLING MADNESS at or near the two path for much of the opening half, was gradually worked into path three coming up to the three-eighths pole, got angled out six wide from upper to midstretch, lacked the needed response. CURLIN'S LEGACY took up the chase towards path two while never making its presence felt. DECADENCE spotted two wide on the turn, failed to menace. RIENDO hung out in path five at the three-eighths pole, was never involved. BIG HORN RANGER four wide entering the exiting the turn, was never in it. TRAIN IN VAIN along the inside route disputing the pace early, retreated after completing the half.
