Footnotes

ALIEN SEASON away forwardly placed, remained so, slid across several paths and over to the inside route, with the starting gate having been positioned from the middle of the course outward, duelled with MARTINO to its outside, pulling with force on the bit during the setting of the first fraction, had that fight spill into the stretch and got set down, lost little if any ground during the ensuing furlong yet failed to shake free, dug in game in the last stages to stay in the clear. OUTRAGEOUS BET sat reserved in the two path stalking the ongoing pace dispute, was put to a drive as the half was being reached, ventured out in the direction of path eight making his way down the lane, in part due to HOPPER DROPPER drifting out itself, rallied in fine fashion nevertheless to garner the place. HOPPER DROPPER took up the chase from the two path, drifted out into path seven racing down the down, missed out on the place. MOUNT UPTON broke a half length the tardiest of all, responded to some light encouragement to reach midpack, cut over to the rail past the half mile pole, was put to a drive after a few additional strides, got spotted three wide at the head of the stretch, gained well. MR. CAT mostly two wide on the backstretch, sneaked his way into the pocket at the half mile pole, was on hold forced to bide time late on the bend, had room to slip by right around the three-sixteenths marker, was given its cue but instead flattened out. MARTINO sparred for command from the two path to midlane before giving way. OH SO SINISTER two wide entering the turn, was six wide exiting it, failed to menace. DUBLIN LEPRECHAUN saved ground on the turn to no avail. LEATHERHEAD LURIE raced two wide on the turn, commenced the stretch a couple of paths farther off the rail, was never involved. Due to a teletimer malfunction, only the final time was available.
