Footnotes

CADEYRN got hooked up a duel with HEY JABBER JAW just about from the get-go, cut over to the inside and took part in it, lightly hand urged by the rider, shifted into the two path when put to a drive at the head of the stretch, dug in stubbornly to hold off all the others. CANDID DESIRE chased the ongoing pace dispute from the two path, fanned out into path five from upper to midstretch, straightened away and rallied with good energy to procure the place. THREEFIVEINDIA came away without apparent mishap, was positioned momentarily in the pocket late on the backstretch before altering plans and out-racing SILVER RIDE for position by angling three to four wide onto the turn, was patiently ridden perched within striking distance of the fighting front runners, got asked to pick up interest as the half was being completed, made no headway from upper to midlane then was outfinished for the place. SILVER RIDE proceeded along the backstretch under some hand urging, got hung out four wide at the half mile pole after being out-sprinted for the path three by THREEFIVEINDIA, had the pilot apply strong left side pressure and drag the mount into path two, was still there being set down for the drive home, altered to rail in the three-sixteenths marker, had no late gain. SASSICAIA on the receiving end of several right handed shots in the shadow of the starting gate, failed to get motivated, saved ground for almost a half, was angled four wide into the stretch and lacked the necessary response. HEY JABBER JAW sparred with the winner two to three wide for a half before giving way.
