DANCELAND off to a sluggish begining, made it over to the inside well before departing the clubhouse bend, responded to light hand encouragement once off turn one and picked up interest between calls on the backstretch, sat on hold drafting behind DOLCE LILI after more than halfway around the second turn, managed to inch its way into the two path approaching the quarter pole, paused at that staton then was turned loose after stepping onto the head of the stretch, made some headway during the ensuing furlong, espied a freshly-created seam in lane three a short distance beyond the eighth pole and eagerly dove over to it, kicked into her best and closed into the gap, was batting tenaciously outside two others in the final seventy yards, poked the head down in time at the wire to earn the decision. LION IN WAIT away forwardly placed, established control before stepping off the first turn, cut over to the inside, showed the way, coaxed by the rider and with TIZZELLE in accompaniment out in path two, saw that rival get cranked up for a challenge after completing three-quarters, stepped into the lane under solid urging, built up the advantage during the trip leading up to and then through the furlong grounds, had it chopped into steadily thereafter initially by DOLCE LILI and then by the eventual winner, vied inside that pair in the final stages and although determined to the end, got nipped. DOLCE LILI kept an eye on the front runners well rated in the pocket for nearly six furlongs, was cued up at the commencement of the stretch run, began to cut into the deficit at the start of the final furlong, tipped into path two leaving the sixteenth marker, without appearing to lose any momentum, vied from between the first two finishers from there onward but came up short. TIZZELLE rated in the two path prompting the pacesetter, got called upon preparing for a challenge in earnest past the five-sixteenths pole, put in that bid but got staved off. PHANTOM OPENING took up chase from path two, was put to a drive leaving the three-eighths pole, spun three wide into the lane, straightened away and was outfinished. CHUBBY STAR reserved in path two in midpack early, was travelling three wide by the five-sixteenths pole, got driven one path farther off the rail into the stretch, lacked the needed response.
