Footnotes

ZIGARCH strung out approximately three wide for most of the trip on the chute, continued at a considerable distance from off the inside throughout, was gradually tipped out wider and wider during the run around the full bend until in path five by the five-sixteenths marker, got cued up angling one more farther off the inside into the stretch, began to close in on the front runners, came in momentarily and slightly after several interspersed right handed shots with under a sixteenth remaining, herding JUPITER RISING a bit inward, and leading EXCLUSIVE ZIP, at the time making no discernable progress on the front runners, into getting pinched, got corrected, then mustering up enough of a kick and good courage went on to get the job done. STORM PROPHET carried in by SOUTHERN UNION at the start, underwent a three wide journey for six furlongs, commenced the stretch one path wider having been set down, rallied with good energy en route for the place. E J'S LEGACY bumped after the start, stalked the leader two to three wide, was more in path three for the start of the stretch drive, held on well enough to secure the show. JUPITER RISING got checked after veering out sharply at the break, got strung out four wide on the chute, moved closer to the inside, raced towards the two path but from between rivals on the turn, swung into action by coming five wide into the lane, closed in on the front runners, got herded inward slightly by the winner late, eventually getting steaded, got going again in short order and made some headway. JO'S BOLD CAT came out and bumped into the nearest rival at the start, that being SUPER HAWK, sat reserved two to three wide on the turn,

got roused at the head of the stretch and rallied mildly. LEAD BY EXAMPLE raced towards the inside, was kept on hold waiting behind another during the going from the five-sixteenths pole to the end of the full bend, continued to idle along during the opening phases of the stretch drive, steadied and altered course at the furlong grounds, after encountering additional traffic along the inside route, was let out a notch and responded by making some headway, was forced to steady a second time after closing up to the heels of the former pacesetter in deep stretch, tipped back into the two path, finished the race lightly urged and appearing to have some run left. SUPER HAWK bumped solidly by JO'S BOLD CAT as the field was sent off and running, loped along towards the two path, got sent seven wide down the lane while never getting involved. EXCLUSIVE ZIP bumped in the shadow of the starting gate, raced three to two wide for three-quarters, angled about four wide into the lane, wasn't making any headway when pinched in deep stretch, failed to recover interest afterwards. SOUTHERN UNION showed the way from the two path, gave in to heavy pressure in upper stretch and faltered. DEARIE loosely pocketed, gave way. HERE COMES TOMMY saved ground for three-quarters, was asked for a response coming three wide into the stretch, came up empty. Following a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the stretch drive, in addition to claims of fouls lodged by the riders of both JUPITER RISING and EXCLUSIVE ZIP against the rider of ZIGARCH alleging interference, the result was allowed to stand and the race was declared official.
