Footnotes

WHYNOTVANNA slow start with no early speed while lagging back to the turn, rallied wide into the stretch and closed fast in the drive to go clear in a good effort. RHODIUM ONE was slow early and far back to the turn, rallied and weaving in and out of traffic in the stretch, split foes late while gaining on the winner and may have been best today. KANKLE tracked dueling trio in front from inside, raced four wide out of the turn and went evenly in the late stages from outside. G CODE vied from the rail to the turn, stayed well in the drive but finally weakened late. GLISTENING STAR vied from three wide to the turn, led late in the stretch but was outrun to the wire. VOULE ESSERE raced evenly to the stretch but came up empty in the drive. LINA'S CONQUEST never a threat. COLLEEN'S SONG vied from between horses to the turn but gave way readily thereafter.
