Footnotes

ABOUNDING JOY dueled early on, angled off the rail in the turn, was under a long drive down the lane and prevailed in the final stages. LANEY chased the pace early, fanned into the five path in the turn, was under a long drive in the stretch but did not have enough in the final stages. IT WAS CONSIDERED stalked the pace early, shifted into the three path in the turn, was under a long drive in the stretch but did not have enough late. WHAT A STAR checked along the backstretch from the rail, shifted into the four path in the turn, lacked room in the stretch, altered out around foes and flattened out late in the drive. MEMORIAL DRIVE dueled early on, shifted into the three path in the turn and leveled off down the lane. TRUE BOOTS chased the pace early, shifted into the four path in the turn while making a bid but weakened late in the stretch. BEMUS POINT trailed the field throughout.
