CROSS ME AGAIN saved ground off the pace, bid nearing the three eighths pole, progressed in the three path of the far turn, dueled between horses most of the lane and took the nod through later yards. JUST A LIL LUKEY settled back in the three path, bid nearing the three eighths pole, rounded the far turn five wide then dueled the length of the stretch to take second the final yards while outfinished for the win. TALENT QUEST rated a slim lead inside, dug in at even terms to the challenge of Fire Moon from the seven sixteenths pole, turned that one back and pulled clear past the quarter but was headed later yards and reluctantly ceded nearing the wire. NO HUNTING rated close toward the inside, bid nearing the three eighths pole, raced in range of the lead off the rail rounding the far turn then flattened stride the final sixteenth. STOCK BROKER raced well back leaving the first turn, saved ground on the far turn and finished evenly at the rail. FIRE TIGAR raced in the three and four paths the first turn, bid nearing the three eighths pole then faded in the six path of the far turn. FIRE MOON tapered in through the front stretch and raced with the pace then stalked the pace two deep into the first turn, challenged leaving the seven sixteenths pole, engaged in close chase from that point but dropped back past the quarter, gave way on the turn then eased in the stretch.
