Footnotes

IFURNOTFIRSTURLAST took over at the half mile pole and set a pressured pace, contested the advantage off the rail rounding the turn and dug in under steady encouragement to hold off the stretch challenge of UPPERVILLE, who gave chase from the three and four paths, and dug in a close factor through the lane but needed a bit more. FOR THE LOVE pressured the pace three wide, contested at a close disadvantage through the turn, raced evenly to late stretch but flattened stride nearing the wire. BADABOOM chased the early pace outside, rounded the turn four wide and finished evenly. LETS DANCE JACK pressured the pace from the inside and had a slim brief lead past the five sixteenths pole but faded rounding the turn. FREEDOM STORM chased the pace off the rail, angled out through the turn, left the turn six wide and finished evenly. POET WARRIOR chased the pace from the inside, raced at the rail on the turn then weakened.
