MY MISSION Broke sluggishly, contested the lead from the outset, took the rail on the turn, kicked clear when asked and then was whipped to the line. KATINA GOT EVEN Was unhurried four wide, three path around the turn, angled wide and rallied to earn the place. MISS PEARL Was well placed along the two path into the turn, three path into the lane and finished well. SLIDING STONES Was well placed along the three path around the turn, chased the winner outside in the lane and weakened. FUHRELLE Saved ground and finished evenly. SPLASHY RISE Broke awkwardly spotting the field two lengths, four wide into the lane and failed to threaten. INDIAN LEGACY Contested the lead along the three path to the turn, two path around it and gave way.
