Footnotes

RICO CAPOTE Away well, set the pace along the two path, responded when roused and widened to be ridden out. MOP HEAD Broke sluggishly, saved ground on the turn, responded inside and closed well. PATRON SAINT Tracked along the rail into the lane, eased out and weakened. STOP SIGN Tracked the winner along the three path to the lane, angled out in the lane and weakened. JET SET CAT Four wide into the lane, five wide out of it and weakened. BRASSTOWN SHERIFF Was well placed four wide on the turn and tired.
