TERMINAL SPEED Away well, tracked along the two path, got to even terms at the top of the lane, battled on and under the whip drew clear late. SEE ME COMING Tracked the leaders along the rail midway on the turn, took the three path into the lane and finished well. IAMPOE Set the pace along the rail, was hooked, battled inside and weakened. RED HOOK EXPRESS Never far back, gained five wide into the lane and hung. DRUID'S GLEN Was unhurried along the two path into the bend, angled out some in the lane, gained and hung. N Y UTOPIA Was unhurried along the rail, gained inside into the lane and hung. YOUR TOUCH Was well placed along the three path around the turn, four wide into it and tired. EINSTEIN AFFAIR Stumbled badly at the start spotting the field four lengths and then was outrun.
