ALL ABOUT THAT BEN sprinted to a clear lead soon after the start, increased his margin while never being challenged, then drew off in the lane and was kept to the task. TELLMEAFHOOKYSTORY mid pack, looped three and four wide through the second turn, bid four wide into the stretch, made a steady gain and edged up for the place. GARON TOWER stalked the pace on the outside, bid outside of that one into the lane, then weakened late and held the show. SUPER HAWK chased the pace, held position two and three wide through the second turn, bid three wide into the lane and got up for a share. DAN THE MAN was no factor, inside. TRUST IN RUSS was never involved.
