TENDER BOY sprinted to a clear lead soon after the start, increased his margin without challenge, then drew off in the lane and was kept to the task. EMPEROR'S GOLD fractious in the gate, stalked the pace on the outside, bid three wide outside of that one into the lane, then drifted in late and weakened. IMAGINAR mid pack, looped up three and four wide through the second turn, bid four wide into the lane and closed well for the show. HAZEN'S NOTCH allowed to settle, saved ground through the turn, came through inside of rivals into the lane, made a steady gain, then steadied slightly in the late going and could not gain. PURSUING JUSTICE passed a tiring rival. TOYSHOP was a brief factor, outside. A CLAIM OF FOUL LODGED BY THE RIDER OF HAZEN'S NOTCH AGAINST THE RIDER OF EMPEROR'S GOLD WAS ALLOWED
