JUSTONEMOREPATRON stalked the pace on the outside, held position three wide through the turn, bid on that path into the stretch, made a steady gain and edged up late. FIRST IN CLASS bobbed at the start, saved ground through the turn, came through inside of rivals into the stretch, angled out for clear racing room and missed. GUARDIAN set the pace from between rivals, shook clear inside the furlong marker, weakened and held the show. HAIL TO LE ROI mid pack, saved ground through the turn, came through inside of rivals into the stretch, angled out for clear racing room and lacked the needed late kick. GHOST SHIP allowed to settle, looped up three and four wide through the turn, bid four wide into the stretch and evened out. I WILL ROCK YOU vied for the early lead on the inside while bearing out, saved ground through the turn, came through inside of rivals into the stretch and faded the final furlong. OUR GOLDEN CHANCE was no factor.
