AVAIL EKATI Was well placed, gained along the three path on the last turn, responded outside and finished with good energy to miss. HELICAL SPRING Never far back four wide, gained on that path into the lane and closed well. HOLY WEEK Lagged back along the rail, gained into the lane, altered out for never and rallied. LION SLEEPS Vied for the lead along the two path to the last turn and weakened. TELLMEAFHOOKYSTORY Ducked out at the start, six wide after a half mile, four wide on the last turn and finished wide. DUBLIN PUB Was well placed along the rail and tired. SALEAS Was unhurried five wide, continued five wide on the final turn and finished wide. ZABABA Vied for the lead along the three path, two path on the last turn and tired.
