PAGE MCKENNEY raced two to three wide in the first turn, was well placed just off striking range while settled comfortably awaiting riders command, steadily guided up to the leader entering far turn, took command past the three eighth pole, quickly cleared on top and remained sharp to the end. MISHEGAS was reserved racing in or near the back, showed good response when asked leaving the backstretch, circled up closer in far turn, continued solid bid but was no match for clear leader, finished clearly second best. JAY'S WAY raced five wide in the first turn then stalked in second flight, gave rivals the slip and took closer order racing just off leader, kept under strong ride three wide near the quarter pole, weakened off the top pair along inside in the lane, cleared the rest for share. DIAMOND BACHELOR raced off the early pace, hustled up two wide entering far turn then swung out wider, continued driving along outside into the lane, improved position without threatening late leaders. CATHOLIC COWBOY settled nicely off the early pace, launched three wide bid near the three eighths pole, showed response then weakened. BOLD ENVOY raced three to four wide in the first turn, stalked up close through the backstretch then retreated in far turn. TOUGH CUSTOMER dropped far back and failed to be a factor. FLOWERS FOR LISA set the pace through the backstretch, lost the lead at three eighths pole and quickly retreated. FLASHY JEWEL raced up close in early stages then came up empty and quickly retreated.
