STAKES Gulfstream Park Sprint S. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. Free nomination by Sunday, February 17. \$1,000 to enter. \$100,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stakes since September 1 allowed 2 lbs.; a stakes since September 1, 4 lbs.; three races other than maiden, claiming, or starter, 6 lbs. Starters to be named by usual time of closing. Supplemental nominations may be made at time of entry. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. This race will be limited to 14 starters, with also eligibles. Preference will be given to graded stakes winners, then by highest career earnings.

RECRUITING READY broke inward slightly and was off a step slow, went along chasing behind MY CHINUMADO and boxed in by QUIJOTE up the backstretch, maneuvered out three wide as the latter went up to get the lead passing the seven-sixteenths, poked a head in front challenging QUIJOTE a quarter-mile out, gained the upper hand through the furlong grounds, and moved clear vigorously hand urged and shown the whip. QUIJOTE pressed the pace from the outset, took over outside MY CHINUMADO midway on the turn, fought back when confronted by RECRUITING READY approaching the top of the lane, could not match strides past the eighth-pole but ran on willingly. SWEETONTHELADIES raced two then three wide around the turn, and rallied outside going clear for the show while never a threat for anything more. STORM ADVISORY went three to four wide through the turn, and lacked the needed response. SANTIAMEN saved ground and was not a factor. PASS THE BUTTER was overmatched four then five wide to the lane. MILLIONAIRE RUNNER hit the left side of the gate and was off slowly, felt the whip into the turn and had no response. MY CHINUMADO was sent hard for the lead inside, lost the advantage to QUIJOTE before completing three furlongs, and dropped back steadily.
