CODESEVENTYSEVEN set the pace and saved ground through backstretch, repelled bid from HARD WORKER leaving the three eighths pole, held firm turning for home then kept clear under steady encouragement. BUNYAN'S AXE raced in contention positioned off top trio at half mile marker, made three wide move at the quarter pole, continued to chase after winner in stretch and edged foe for place. AM PREPARED settled early stages racing in range, under a ride along rail at the quarter pole, cut the corner entering top stretch and continued steady inside bid through the lane. HOT TRAFFIC was unhurried saving ground through early stages, picked up pace late backstretch, made bid between rivals leaving far turn, raced four wide late stages and edged closer. HARD WORKER raced in tracking mode off the leader, lodged bid up to challenge CODESEVENTYSEVEN for lead at three furlong marker, could not move on with eventual winner, kept along inside upper stretch then gave way. FORTUNICKLE tracked the pace racing three wide through backstretch, under a ride three to four wide in final turn then came out wide turning for home and lacked further response. BAD BOY E. J. dropped back and lost contact with the field, eased to wire, pulled up shortly after then walked off. No run up distance
